RESEARCH GRANTS IN TOBACCO CONTROL

Bangladesh Center for Communication Programs (BCCP) has been implementing a Research Grant Program on Tobacco Control Policy in collaboration with the Institute for Global Tobacco Control based at the Johns Hopkins Bloomberg School of Public Health, Baltimore, USA since 2013. BCCP is now inviting 4th round proposals from postgraduate students and researchers. The purpose of the Research Grant is to promote tobacco control policy research in Bangladesh. Twenty grants will be available for this round.

The research topic must be within the priority issues of the Bloomberg Initiative to Reduce Tobacco Use. Proposals generating local evidence that may contribute to developing new policies or strengthening existing ones in line with the components of World Health Organization's MPOWER package are recommended.
